


Housing support and homelessness prevention for vulnerable people across East Sussex.



We support individuals and families:

- who are homeless
- at risk of losing their home
- living in temporary accommodation
- living in unsuitable accommodation
- with resettlement issues
- to sustain accommodation and live independently

Home Works supports people with care and support needs to solve their housing problems and avert crisis.

Home Works is a short-term housing support service in East Sussex committed to helping vulnerable people find and keep affordable and safe accommodation.

The holistic, personalised support we provide also addresses other issues in clients' lives that are putting the security and stability of their housing at risk.

We work in close partnership with referring services to achieve sustainable client outcomes, including helping clients develop longer-term strategies.

"Our primary concern is that our clients' housing is secure. However, there are often underlying issues. Support is tailored to each client's needs to enable them to get back in control and help stop their situation from getting worse."

Eligibility:

All of the following criteria must be met:

- ✓ The applicant is known to Adult Social Care
- ✓ The applicant/household is experiencing one or more of the housing problems listed overleaf
- ✓ The member of the household who will be the lead on receiving Home Works support is aged 16-59 years
- ✓ The member of the household who will be the lead on receiving Home Works support is willing to accept and engage with Home Works support
- ✓ The issues the applicant/household are experiencing can be meaningfully addressed through short-term support
